Course Overview

PRINCE2® is a world recognised process based project management method that is easily tailored and scalable for the management of all types of projects within your organisation. PRINCE2® is rapidly becoming the de facto Project Management method within Australia being widely used across government and commercial sectors alike.

This three day Foundation course will provide you with a sound understanding of the PRINCE2® components and process model and will prepare you for sitting the PRINCE2® Foundation Exam (1 hour multi-choice) at the end of the course. Exercises are used throughout this course to reinforce learning. Exercise sessions account for approximately 20% of the course.

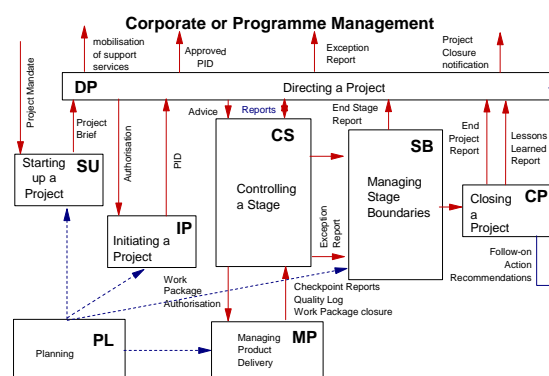
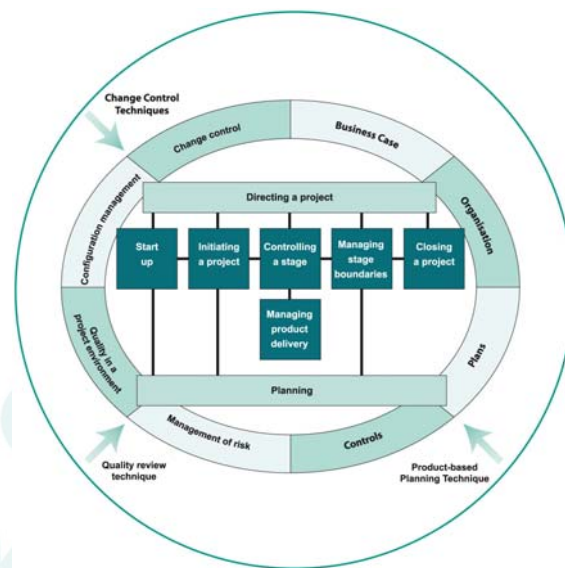
This course is offered publicly or can be delivered in-house within your organisation.

For those wishing to sit the PRINCE2® Practitioner Exam also, this course will be followed by a two-day PRINCE2® Practitioner Course focused on practical application, further coverage of the PRINCE2® techniques and preparation for sitting the PRINCE2 Practitioner Exam. The PRINCE2® Practitioner Exam will be sat on the afternoon of day 2 of this course.
