

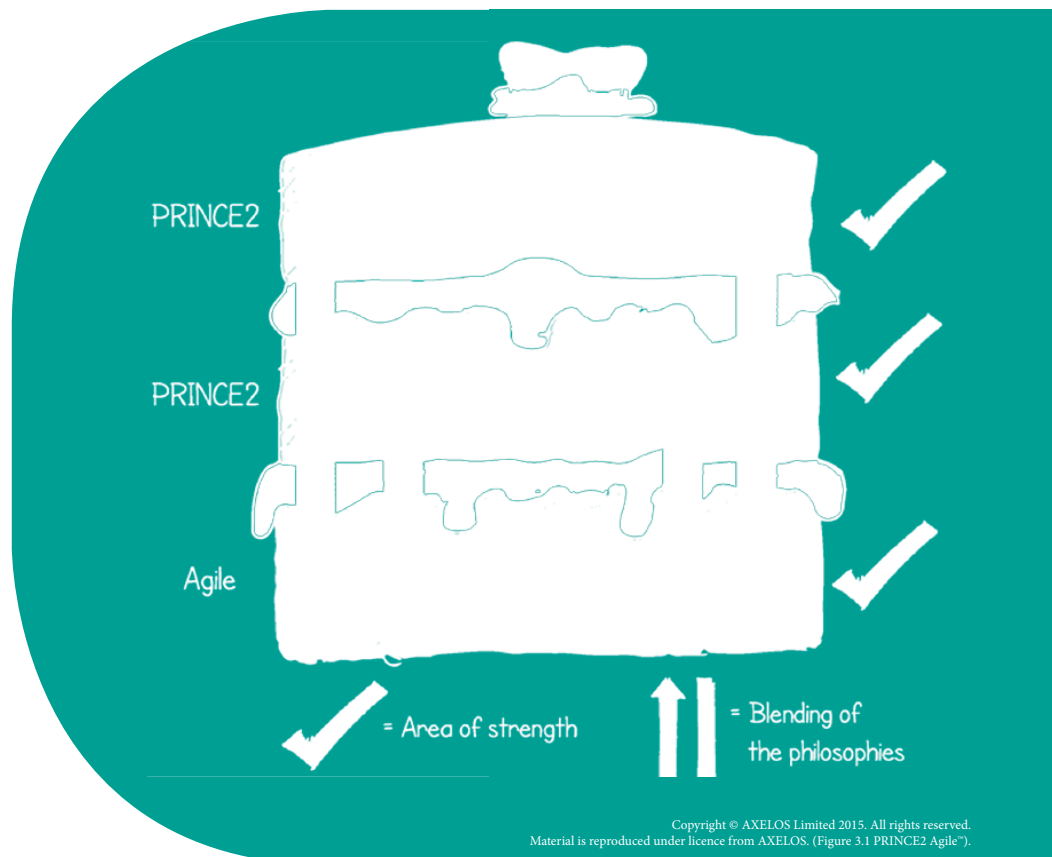

The best-practice guidance shows how organizations can harness the compatibility between PRINCE2 and Agile, equipping them with the required knowledge, skills and processes to successfully deliver projects to meet customer requirements in today's fast-paced and rapidly-changing business environments.



About the course

This half-day Executive Briefing is designed to provide you with an insight into the purpose and structure of PRINCE2 Agile and how it may be applicable in your organisation.

- » Executives in Agile environments wishing to understand the applicability of PRINCE2 to that environment.
