About the Course

The PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner Course is a 2-day course for those who would like to extend their knowledge of PRINCE2 Agile by learning how to practically apply the PRINCE2 Agile method to real-life scenarios. The course combines instructor lead sessions along with PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner exam practice sessions. The course is designed to effectively prepare you to sit and pass the PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner Exam.



Who Should Attend?

This course is aimed at those who are currently working in, or are looking to work in an agile environment. This may include:

- » Project Managers
- » Team Managers / Team Leaders
- » Project Coordinators / Support
- » Team Members
- » PMO members

In existing agile environments, specific roles may include Scrum Masters, Product Owners, and members of Agile Development Teams. However, please note the course does not revise PRINCE2 material in a lot of detail. The focus is on the concepts of Agile ways of working and how to apply or tailor the PRINCE2 principles, themes and processes in an Agile context.

Course Prerequisites

Candidates must hold a current PRINCE2 Foundation certificate; PRINCE2 Agile Foundation Certificate; or PRINCE2 Practitioner Certificate in order to be eligible to sit the PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner exam.

Please note that whilst no pre-course reading is required, very little time is allocated to the revision of PRINCE2 during the course and a general awareness of the basic concepts of agile ways of working is assumed.

Exercise sessions

Exercise sessions and discussions are used throughout the course to reinforce the learning process. This gives you a practical way to look at how PRINCE2 Agile and agile ways of working can be used in your own workplace.

Course Objectives

On completion of this course you are expected to be able to:

- » Understand the basic concepts of common agile ways of working
- » Understand the purpose and context for combining PRINCE2 and the agile way of working
- » Be able to apply and evaluate the focus areas to a project in an agile context
- » Be able to fix and flex the six aspects of a project in an agile context
- » Be able to apply the PRINCE2 principles and tailor the themes, processes and management products to a project in an agile context.
