Achieving Your Diploma of Project Management Using PRINCE2®


You have always wanted to gain a nationally recognised qualification in project management. Your workplace is beginning to embrace PRINCE2° as the preferred method for delivering projects. Now you can achieve a Diploma of Project Management and develop your PRINCE2° knowledge and skills through one easy approach.

The Diploma of Project Management (BSB50820) is arguably Australia's most desirable project management qualification and the PRINCE2° method the most common method adopted by government departments and agencies.

The Diploma is Australia's nationally recognised competency based qualification. PRINCE2® is a world recognised process based project management method that is easily tailored and scalable for the management of all types of projects within your organisation.

Project Management provides a mechanism to allow you and your organisation to plan and deliver new business products in a controlled and reliable manner, which in-turn enables outcomes and benefits to be realised. However, to enable you to be successful as a project manager or team manager you must be equipped with the appropriate skills and be competent to perform your role effectively. This 4 day hands-on course will equip you with the fundamental principles and skills of project management based upon recognised best practice (PRINCE2°) and to develop these as competencies during the assessment period.

During the course, practical sessions focus on the development of management documentation for a workplace project and these will be developed further during assessment.








Upon successful achievement of your Diploma qualification post course development pathways include credits towards higher level qualifications, professional recognition by the Australian Institute of Project Management and certifications in PRINCE2° at Foundation or Practitioner level.

This course is offered publicly or can be delivered in-house within your organisation, with flexible timetables that can be varied to suit your availability. All courses are focused on pragmatic application within your workplace and are run by appropriately qualified project management professionals, who continue to build on their experiences as Tanner James consultants.

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The course provides participants with the sound theoretical and practical knowledge of project management principles and processes and the application of tools, techniques and methods crucial to a successful project.



Course Objectives

The course will provide you with an overall understanding of the nine knowledge areas of project management as well as the principles, themes and processes of PRINCE2°.

By the end of the course you will have developed your understanding of your case study project and will have produced some elementary management documentation to further develop and apply in the workplace.

You will also have gained an understanding of the required assessment process that leads to the award of the Diploma of Project Management.

Units of Competency to be Completed

- Manage project scope
- Manage project time
- Manage project quality
- Manage project cost
- Manage project human resources
- Manage project information and communication
- Manage project risk
- Manage project integration
- Plus four preferred units from a suite of electives.

Participation & Assessment

Attendance over the duration of the course and active participation is required through class discussions and individual case study activities. This will start to inform the facilitator regarding your knowledge and understanding of the topics. There is no formal exam.

The award of the Diploma of Project Management will be dependent upon the participant demonstrating knowledge of project management and providing a portfolio of project documentation as evidence of their project management competencies.

Each of the eight units of competency plus four elective units must be addressed and satisfied to achieve the diploma. There is a post course period of six months allowed for the participant to complete the assessment tasks.

Course Prerequisites

Participants need to have access to an emerging workplace (the case study) project either as the project manager or team leader within the project organisation. The case study project will be considered and worked upon by the participant during the course and final documentation developed by the participant post course will be used to determine the participant's competency for the award of the diploma.

Who Should Attend?

This course is for anyone wishing to develop their knowledge and skills in project management through the application of the PRINCE2° method. It is ideal for candidates who are either new to project management or have recently been engaged in a project role and require a professional disciplined approach to their work.
